

For a nanny \$565 (one infant child) At a day care center (one infant child)

At a summer day camp \$304 (one child)

A dependent care FSA can save up to 30% on child care costs.



It can also be used to care for elderly and disabled dependents

Maximum for dependent care FSA



\$5,000 married couples filing jointly



\$2,500 filing separately

set aside \$5,000, multiply by the average U.S. tax rate (28.9%)

save \$1,445 per year by setting aside money
